

Filling out the census on your own — self-responding — is the best way to get counted.

Higher self-response rates mean fewer people are likely to be missed or counted inaccurately and fewer households will have a visit from a census taker to be counted in-person. It also means the community has a better chance at receiving its fair share of services and political representation.
